
## LibSoft Features & Benefits

LibSoft is mk's flagship and in-house designed like all mk products, fully web-based solution that uses the latest HTML5 technology, making icons and screens familiar to patrons. The software works with the library's touchscreen monitors, PCs and is compatible with different Operating Systems, interfacing to your ILS via SIP2/NCIP/WebServices. Staff are able to change the patron interface and customize receipts without having to re-boot.

LibSoft accesses patron accounts via their library cards to return items; however, for full account access, patrons can either present their card or enter their patron number manually (PIN request can be enabled).

The language and appearance are easily changed by the patron at the SelfCheck, and cover images of items are clearly shown on the screen alongside checkout/check-in, renewal, and return confirmation. LibSoft enhances the patron experience by providing a simple-to-use method to perform everyday tasks of checking out, returning, paying fines and fees, and handling renewals. Receipt options are available via print or email.

While LibSoft processes all existing data models, the software can also automatically re-encode the tags to a standard data model like ISO 28560-2 - ideal for ongoing conversion activities at one branch or different data models used across a system. For joint-use libraries, LibSoft can also connect to different ILS simultaneously, allowing patrons to return items from other libraries and check them in with the other library's ILS.
