Manual Tagging Station Features & Benefits

The mk Manual Tagging Station helps to simplify the tagging/conversion process and can accommodate multiple data models.

Station includes barcode scanner, RFID reader/writer with shielded antenna, two roll tag dispensers to accommodate different sets of tags, tagging software, and optionally a laptop/netbook, which is integrated into a sturdy, mobile cart designed for moving in between the aisles of the library with ease.

Tagging of approximately 350 items per hour, including both single and multi-piece items. Audible and visual signals and alerts indicate successful conversion of items to staff. No connection to your ILS is required; staff can perform offline conversion activities including weeding.
